Conditions:

- a.** All entries must be bona fide work of the exhibitor.
- b.** No more than one entry may be entered in any one Class by a single exhibitor.
- c.** All entries must have the name of the exhibitor and the Section Class number on the back.
- d.** Entries in Classes 5000 - 5020 papers must be mounted on cartridge paper or cardboard of a suitable colour, the mount being preferably of a "cut-out" type with no more than 5cm around the edge.
- e.** Artwork sizes: Years 3 to 6: A5 or A4, Years 7 to 12: A5 or A4. All mediums to be on paper or canvas sheets. No canvas boards. No wooden articles etc unless mounted on paper or card. Paper to be no larger than specified size.
- f.** Digital drawing work can include photographs but must be dramatically altered.
- g.** Previous winning entries of a Mount Gambier Show award in any Class are disqualified from

re-entry.

- h. Inappropriate artwork themes will be refused entry. Decision of Stewards is final.
- i. A violation of any of the foregoing Rules automatically disqualifies the entry.
- j. Judges decision is final.
- k. Every possible effort will be made to display all exhibits in space provided.
- l. No responsibility will be incurred by the Society for any loss or damage by fire, act of God or any cause whatsoever.
