All riders and exhibitors must be members of the Mount Gambier Agricultural and Horticultural Society Inc.

Society Membership fees:

Annual \$36 (includes Member & Car)

Junior \$15 (under 18 at 1.5.24) (Member only)

Competitors One Day Membership \$20 (one single day Member's Ticket).

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES

Horse Pass: \$20 per horse. Entitles the horse to enter in ALL CLASSES in the Horses In Action section except Show Jumping. Horse Passes at \$20 each available until **Sunday 13**th **October**. This date will be strictly enforced to allow time to send out required info.

Show Jumping: Pre-entries compulsory, closing 13th October

DOGS

No loose dogs allowed on the grounds. Any loose dogs will be impounded with the resultant fees payable to the City of Mount Gambier.

EXERCISING HORSES

Horses are permitted to exercise on the main arena prior to 8am each day. No lunging on main arena unless weather permits.

AGE OF COMPETITORS

The age of all competitors is to be the actual age on the first day of the Show (excluding Show Jumping) – 24th October. Proof of age (e.g. birth certificate) must be produced on request.

VEHICLES

Only licensed drivers are to be in charge of all vehicles including motorised scooters and helmets must be worn. All SA road rules apply on the Showgrounds.

PORTABLE YARDS

Portable yards are permitted in the secured paddock areas only. As per EA rules, all yards must be of a solid construction and no electric fences are permitted. Yards are not to exceed 5m x 5m.

PROTESTS

All protests must be in writing with a deposit of \$50 in the hands of a Committee Member no later than 30 minutes after the alleged dispute. The deposit will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

JUDGING

The Society reserves the right to substitute a judge when deemed necessary. Persons other than judges and stewards are not permitted in the ring unless permission is granted by the judge. Horses must not enter the ring until called by the steward. Any animal which, in the opinion of the judge or steward, is considered dangerous will be removed from the ring.

CORRECT ATTIRE

It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse anywhere on the Showground including practice and schooling areas to wear approved boots and protective headgear approved under the current Australian, European or American Standard.

The onus is on the rider to comply with the rules regarding helmets, and their insurance may be rendered void in the event of an accident/injury if they are found to have been using a noncompliant helmet. Riders under 18 years are not permitted to wear high top riding boots, or gaiters, in riding classes.

ENTIRES

Stallions MUST have the appropriate GREEN DISC at ALL times while on the grounds.

An entire Horse, Galloway or Pony will not be permitted to compete in sections other than Dressage, Harness, Jumping, Hunts and Hurdles and specified classes in Open Led, Led and Ridden Breeds.

SCHEDULE & ALTERATIONS

No classes in any rings will be held. Report promptly to ring upon commencement of your class.

The Society reserves the right to make alterations to the Schedule without notice.

SWABBING

Swabbing as per FEI and EA Rules and Regulations may take place. The owner or their representative may be present during testing, but shall not interfere in any way with the conduct of a test, and will observe the instructions of the veterinary surgeon on duty.

STANDARD HEIGHTS

Hacks – over 15 hands (1524mm)

Galloways – over 14 hands (1422mm) and not exceeding 15 hands (1524mm)

Ponies – not exceeding 14 hands (1422mm)

MEASURING

No Measuring Steward will be available at the Show except to settle in case of a protest. A current height certificate must be produced if requested by the Judge. Current year certificates from Royal Shows or official EA and SHC measuring days accepted.

CAMPING

Fees: \$20 per night per camping site

Camping to be booked online with entries.

Electrical cables – all electrical cables must be tested and have current compliance tags.

STABLING

Stables/undercover yards available to Members only at a cost of \$60 per stable/undercover yard. Stabling to be booked on https://entry.equipe.com Stables available firstly to competitors living more than 100kms from the Showgrounds. Other applications welcome and allocated on an "availability basis". If not allocated a stable/undercover yard money will be refunded. A refundable bond of \$20 per stable/undercover

yard,. The stable/undercover yard to be cleaned to the satisfaction of the Committee. Power will not be available in the stable area AT ANY TIME. Please refer to the Stabling/Camping Request for further details.

Post & rail yards available to members only at a cost of \$30 per yard.

WASTE DISPOSAL

Stable waste (including manure) must be placed in the areas provided. Day & Overnight Exhibitors please note that all refuse (including manure) must be disposed of responsibly. Please clean up your area and fill in any holes before leaving the grounds.

FODDER

Exhibitors must arrange their own fodder requirements. A general range of stock feeds will be delivered to the Showgrounds between 5pm & 6pm daily. Orders may be placed by phoning The Produce Store on 08 8725 0377.

TRAFFIC CONTROL & PARKING

For the duration of the Show the speed limit is 5 kph (walking pace). Float & truck parking in designated areas only.

FIREWORKS

There will be a Fireworks Display on the Arena on Saturday at approximately 8.30pm. All livestock remaining on the grounds are to be supervised during the display. Exhibitors leave their horses on site at their own risk.

CRUELTY TO HORSES

Cruelty to horses is forbidden either in the arena, exercise areas or elsewhere. The show is

conducted under current EA, where welfare of the horse is paramount.

DISCLAIMER

All competitors, or in the case of competitors under 18 years, the parent or guardian of the competitor, must complete the Disclaimer Form before participating in any equestrian activities at this Show. All pre-entries will not be accepted without the completed Disclaimer.

Some things you need to know

The Horse in Action Committee would like to advise it will be necessary to suspend judging whilst the special features, eg utes and grand parade are on the main arena. Please note this is out of the Horses in Action Committee's control. Unfortunately rings will not be held for any other reason. We appreciate the competitors understanding in this matter.

Thoroughbred Sport Horse Assoc Classes TSHA -

All TSHA classes (Section B) to be run concurrently with Sections A.

To be eligible for TSHA classes your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book. No part bred thoroughbreds will be eligible.

To compete in the thoroughbred only classes you must purchase a competition licence with the TSHA through Global Entries

Online. The licence costs \$ 55 and runs for a calendar year from the date you purchased it.

How do I obtain my licence?

- If you don't already have an account with Global Entries it is simple to create one and then follow the instructions above.
